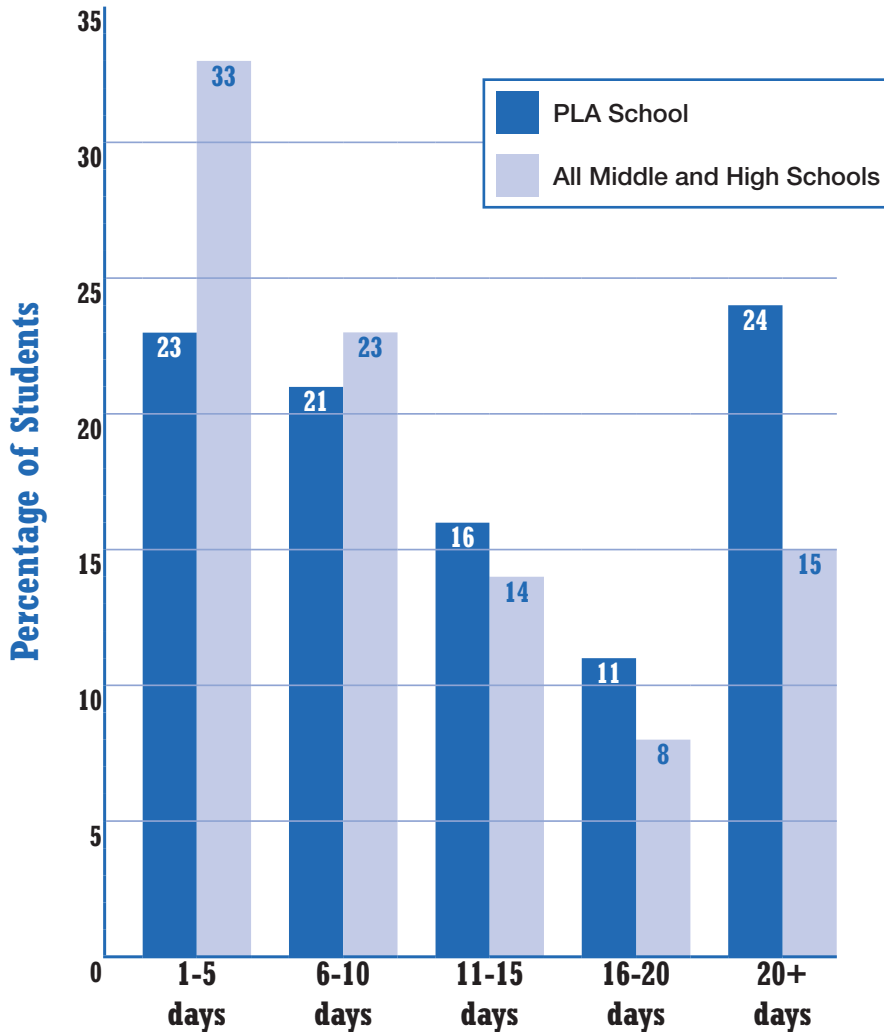




Absenteeism in Persistently Low Achieving Schools in 2010-2011

- As shown in the chart below, the Persistently Low Achieving (PLA) schools have a higher percent of students missing more than 10 days of school compared to the district middle and high schools combined. In particular, there is a large difference in the percentage of students missing more than 20 days of school. At the PLA schools, 24% of their students missed more than 20 days of school compared to 15% for the district.
